Short report on the FlexNet Workshop in Warsaw (22.04.2010)

The Workshop was held on April 22, 2010 in Warsaw, Poland and it preceded the 1st Polish ODEE (Organic, Printed and Elastic Electronics) Conference. The Workshop was addressed to students, young researchers and especially to the industry representatives, not only from the electronic industry. The purpose of the Workshop was to demonstrate the existing industrial application of the organic electronics and to point out the perspectives for Polish companies to join this innovative industry domain. There were ca. 90 participants including 16 industry representatives (from 8 companies and R&D institutes). All lectures were given in the native language (Polish).

The lectures started from a short description of the NoE FlexNet and PolyNet Projects. The main seminars were given by the representatives from European companies and laboratories which have already implemented the production of organic electronics: Dr. Zbigniew Szamel from CSEM and Dr. Wojciech Pisula from EVONIC Industry. Stimulating discussions proved a real interest from the audience. In the last lecture short review of the Polish scientific entities strongly involved in the research in the field of organic electronics was given by Prof. Jacek Ulanski from TUL.
